LEADING FROM THE LAST BREATH

SPEAKER HIGHLIGHT - MARK RODRIGUEZ



Imagine hearing on Christmas Day, "I'm so proud of you, brother." from your hero, the one person you aspired to be like all of your life. What a priceless gift to receive. Then four hours later, answering the phone to hear the most breathtaking news. Your older brother, your idol, passed away sometime after you just spoke to him. The very condition that you shared as a result from lifelong careers as stonemasons finally consumed him. Silicosis fibrosis is a type of pulmonary fibrosis, a lung disease caused by breathing in tiny bits of silica, a common mineral found in sand, quartz and many other types of rock. Silicosis mainly affects workers exposed to silica dust in jobs such as construction and mining. Over time, exposure to silica particles causes scarring in the lungs, which can harm your ability to breathe. This is untreatable by most standards of medical care. Lung transplants are the best-known intervention to date.

Mark Rodriguez, a lifelong Santa Fe, New Mexico resident, and one of nine siblings is the only known living two-time double lung transplant stonemason. Like his older brother, he too has silicosis fibrosis. This once celebrated collegiate athlete hinges on life's scoreboard of reality every day. On Christmas day, Mark felt one of the biggest losses since he had his first set of lungs removed. Mark's oldest brother elected to not have the lung transplant when it was recommended after diagnosis.

Devastated by losing his mother and now his brother within the same year, Mark stands stronger than ever and stated that he is ready to take on stages nationwide and dispel the myth that illness holds you back. As a featured speaker and the catalyst for the development of The Operation IMPACT Tour, Mark will unveil an unprecedented, first-hand account of life's transformation post-surgery.

Mark not only speaks to the physical trauma and recovery of enduring two lung transplants but also the psychological toll it takes on a person that knows that they are fleeing from death's grasp. Remarkably, there isn't the somber sound hovering over the ears of the captivated audience as he tells of the steps as he walked towards heaven's gates. Rather, you will see an impacted crowd ready to take action over their own lives because Mark inspires and empowers the Warrior within each person.

Just as important as the message to the people that attend his talks, Mark has decided that it is time to integrate safety measures and education for companies regarding silicosis fibrosis. Mark, his older brother Ronnie, and countless others have acquired this life-threatening condition through doing nothing more than being a dedicated worker throughout their adult life. This is far too common of an occurrence in these industries.

Mark will be leading the way to igniting changes in safety and awareness for companies to ensure that their workers and their families do not have to feel the impact of such a tragedy of a permanent diagnosis. And for those that are already living with these, and similar, type of conditions, Mark created a one-of-a-kind transformational stage presentation and coaching program that brings life and purpose back to what may once have felt like a hopeless trail of defeat.
